### Chanukah begins at sundown on Wednesday, December 1.

Kindling Chanukah lights is the most important Chanukah custom. This year, we light the first candle on Wednesday, December 1st. We light Chanukah candles to remember the miracle of the Maccabees' victory and the miracle of the oil that burned for eight days in the holy Temple. It is a mitzvah that we "publicize the miracle" by lighting a Chanukah Menorah (also called a Chanukiah) each night during the eight days of Chanukah.

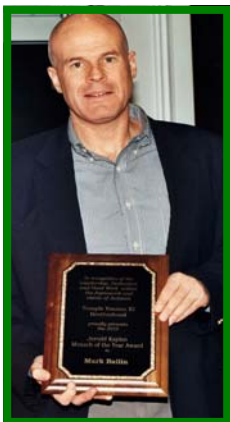

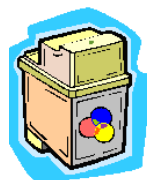
